



Middle School and High School Fundraising Information

In this packet you should be able to find all of the information you need to raise enough money for summer camp. We've got Scrip, Silent Auction, Trash Pick Up, Pizza Palz, and Hot Sauce! **Please note that money not used for 2018 camps will be rolled into the church's general fund.**

Scrip Program: You don't have to sell anything! **You** earn money by making regular household purchases you *would make anyway*. A percentage of every purchase is deposited into your family's fundraising account. Take a look at the scrip directions on the next page of this packet! Please note that all Scrip purchases and redemptions are done online.

Silent Auction: On April 28th & April 29th, 2018. Attached you will find a letter you may bring around to vendors, restaurants, stores, etc. You ask for item donations and these items are then sold at our Silent Auction. If you're willing to put in the work, this can be a huge money maker! **All donations must be marked with the student name, who the item was donated by, and the value and need to be turned into the Student Ministry office by April 16th, 2018!**

#foraurora Service Project - Trash Pick Up: We'll meet at the church at **1:00pm on June 6th, 2018**. We'll pick up trash in our church neighborhood for 4 hours. Be sure to have your pledge sheet filled out. Bring your pledge money on June 6th or as soon as possible following completion of the fundraiser. It should be a fun day and a great way to help out our community.

Pizza Palz: These coupons are sold for \$11 and may be redeemed at any greater Denver area Old Chicago Restaurant for any size pizza up to a \$22 value (see coupons for details). \$6 for each pizza pal sold goes directly into your family's fundraising account. Simply collect the money, bring it to us, and we'll give you the pizza pals to distribute.

Hot Sauce: "students@ehills" hot sauce comes in 3 flavors of deliciousness (Cajun Cayenne, Mango Habanero, and Garlic Cerrano). They sell for \$6 each, and \$3 of that goes directly into your family's fundraising account. Simply collect the money, bring it to us, and we'll give you the hot sauce to distribute. Please remember to ask what kind of hot sauce the buyer wants!

Scrip Program

The scrip program is a way for High School and Middle School Families to help raise money for camps by shopping with gift cards purchased through the Scrip Center for everyday purchases like food, clothing, entertainment, gifts, and vacations. Each scrip card purchased earns a % rebate for the High School and Middle School Family Fundraising Account. There are hundreds of national retailers and local retailers that participate in this program. Start today and go to www.shopwithScrip.com to see a detailed list of national retailers.

We only use online scrip called ScripNow! Sign-up at www.shopwithScrip.com and indicate the Eastern Hills enrollment code: B1E4AL4L19L43. In order to place Scrip orders you must sign up for Presto Pay (direct withdrawal from your bank account). You can then search for ScripNow! retailers. When using ScripNow! you will be able to access your eCard from your ShopWithScrip account. Print it off and redeem it at a store or copy and paste the certificate code for online purchases.

Q: What is scrip?

A: "Scrip" is simply a word that mean "substitute money"- in other words, scrip is "Gift Certificates." If you have ever used a gift certificate, then you've used Scrip. Scrip ca be used to purchase anything, from groceries, fuel, clothing, toys, and cosmetics, to entertainment, electronics, or home improvement items.

When you buy SCRIP through Eastern Hills Community Church, the merchants give EHCC a percentage of your purchase. So if you buy \$50 worth of SCRIP, you get \$50 worth of gift certificates at the merchants of your choice, and the merchants give the church a percentage – usually between 2.5 and 15 percent. This is the fundraising part, your student will get that percentage deposited into their Student Account.

Q: How is scrip used?

A: Just like cash. This means that you just present your SCRIP gift certificate for payment at the register without any restrictions.

Q: How does SCRIP work for Students@ehills?

1. Sign-up at www.shopwithScrip.com and indicate the Eastern Hills enrollment code: B1E4AL4L19L43.
2. SCRIP orders will be purchased through Presto Pay at www.shopwithScrip.com (direct withdrawal from your bank account) Please note that this is something you will need to sign up and be approved for. The approval process does take a number of days to complete.
3. You will receive a 4 digit code. Please email it to jfolan@ehills.org with SCRIPNOW! CODE as the subject. Include your name and your student's name. (If you do not want the percentage rebate to go to a specific student please say General Student Account Fund.) You will then be approved and ready to shop!

4. ShopwithScrip.com Reloadable Gift Cards. A reload icon appears on each page of the ShopwithScrip.com shopping environment. Once you purchase your initial gift card through the Students@ehills program, you can reload it as much as you like.
5. ScripNow! Is the quickest way to purchase Scrip for you or a friend. You can order for yourself or send an eGift in seconds for various retailers. ScripNow! can be delivered and used in minutes simply by using PrestoPay. You will be able to access your eCard from your ShopWithScrip account. Print it off and redeem it at a store or copy and paste the certificate code for online purchases.
6. There is an icon at the top of the ordering page next to Favorites, Reload, and Express Add icons that you can click on for a list of currently available ScripNow! retailers.

Q: How do I sign-up for Presto Pay?

1. Click on the PrestoPay link on your Dashboard.
2. Enter your bank account and account holder information.
3. Within 2-3 business days, Scrip will deposit two small amounts in your bank account from Great Lakes Scrip Center. Record those amounts when you see them.
4. Sign onto www.shopwithscrip.com, enter these amounts in your PrestoPay registration to verify the account, and choose a PIN number to use for online payment.
5. Once you complete the verification, you will see the approval code on that page. Provide that to your organization coordinator to approve you, and once approved by the coordinator, PrestoPay will be available as a payment option at checkout.

Q: Are there any fees incurred by the High School and Middle School Families?

A: Yes

1. With each Presto Pay order there's a small convenience fee to make a Presto Pay payment – \$0.15
